Continuous Auditing and Reporting and the Future of the Auditing Profession

The 30th World Continuous Auditing & Reporting Symposium (30WCARS) will be held at Reykjavik University, Iceland on the 26th of May 2014. The special emphasis at this symposium is how Continuous Auditing and Reporting is affecting and will affect the auditing profession including strategies, tasks, professional qualifications and roles.

The WCARS symposia were started by the Rutgers University Continuous Auditing and Reporting Lab (<http://raw.rutgers.edu/>) and are the leading forum for the discussion of research and practice into the application of information technology to auditing and reporting. The conference alternates between US and non-US locations, with previous non-US conferences held in Monaco (2004), Malta (2005), San Paulo, Brazil (2006-2013), Ferrara, Italy (2007), Crete (2008), Thessaloniki, Greece (2009), Malatya, Turkey (2012) and Brisbane, Australia (2013). Papers, presentations, and proposals for panels are now being sought for 30WCARS with the participation of companies using new accounting and auditing related technology, vendors of such technology and academics researching these issues particularly encouraged. The conference is open to any innovative idea relating to IT-enabled auditing and reporting technology, practice or processes, including, but not limited to:

1. Impact of continuous auditing on the auditing profession
2. Integration of continuous auditing by auditing companies
3. Future revenue models of auditing firms
4. Audit Analytics and Business Intelligence in auditing firms
5. Big Data opportunities for auditing firms
6. Continuous Assurance processes and models
7. XBRL and financial reporting
8. ERP and continuous monitoring
9. Legal frameworks for continuous auditing

We hereby invite internal and external auditors, auditors who are working with continuous auditing and other new AIS technologies, chief financial officers working with financial reporting and academics undertaking research in these areas to this symposium.
